1. NEGARA BRUNEI DARUSSALAM VISA UPDATE

1. NEGARA BRUNEI DARUSSALAM VISA EXEMPTION

The following foreign nationals whose countries have visa arrangements with Brunei Darussalam are exempted from the visa requirement for social, business or professional visits of certain periods provided he/she leaves Brunei Darussalam within the permitted period:

The rest of foreign nationals entering Brunei must have valid visas obtainable from any Brunei Darussalam diplomatic missions abroad except the citizen or passport holder of **Israel** who are not permitted to enter Brunei in whatever occasion but they are allowed to transit and remain on the airside of the airport terminal.

2. NATIONALITY OF AUSTRALIA/PASSPORT HOLDER

Australian passport holders are granted with 2 special privileges: -

i) Normal visa on arrival

- Available "30 days Visa on Arrival (multiple-entries)" for a fee of BND30.00

ii) 72-hour transit visa on arrival

- Similar to the normal 72-hour transit visa as in item 4, but Australian passport holders may leave Brunei via any official point of departure either by air, land or sea transportation.
- Point of entry is still through BWN airport.

3. NATIONALITY OF QATAR/PASSPORT HOLDER

Available to the national of Qatar "14 days Visa on Arrival" for a fee of BND20.00 Single Entry Visa.

4. 72-HOUR TRANSIT VISA ON ARRIVAL

The existing 72-hour transit visa on arrival is applicable to all nationalities **EXCEPT** for the Nationalities/passport holders of **Israel**.

- Passengers must leave the country via original point of entry within 72 hours after arrival to another third country or another point of destination other than the point of origin.
- Passengers must show confirmed onward airline tickets within the prescribed time.
- Passengers must show that they have sufficient fund to support their stay in Brunei Darussalam. However, passengers who are sponsored by a local establishment or individual are not required to produce the above and the sponsor must ensure the passenger leaving within 72 hours limit.
- All passengers are still required to fill in the disembarkation card and pay BND5.00 visa fee.

5. SUFFICIENT FUND

Under the current understanding, a passenger must have at least BND100.00 for every single day of his/her stay in Brunei to meet the criteria unless he/she has a sponsor in Brunei.
