



Ulu Temburong National Park

3 day/2 night Eco-Activity Tour with Evening River Safari

(Guest-house/Guest-house)

Tour Code: IT3-E2BT

Tour Description:

Ulu Temburong National Park is preserved for scientific research, wildlife and visitors. This two night programme gives time to explore, relax, and enjoy this uniquely preserved wilderness. Our air-conditioned Guest-house accommodation is a comfortable and convenient base for this programme. Our experienced guide will adjust the schedule to suit individual preferences, weather, river levels and opening days/times of some venues.

Depart from Bandar Seri Begawan by covered water taxi to Bangar town; watch for wildlife along the way. Visit a small local zoo to see some of the secretive rainforest wildlife, then to our Guest-house for afternoon tea.

Enjoy our 2.5 hour evening River Safari in our aluminium boat to see Proboscis monkeys, crocodiles, Macaques, fireflies and other wildlife along the mangrove lined river. Return to our Guest-house for dinner

Next morning depart early to enjoy the day in Ulu Temburong National Park. Travel by longboat up through the rapids. Look for wildlife, see Durian and other fruiting trees, and notice the rainforest trees becoming larger.

At the National Park walk the 1200 steps to reach the base of the 60m Canopy Walkway towers. Enjoy a panoramic view of the surrounding jungle from the Canopy Walkway; above the trees. Watch for Hornbills, butterflies, Gibbons and other wildlife.

Travel further upstream (subject to river level) to Sg Apan to walk along creeks to jungle waterfalls, and swim in crystal clear pools. Return downstream to the NP by longboat or stop to shoot the rapids on our *Rapid Riders (heavy duty inflatable mattress)*.

Lunch, relax and swim. Then depart downstream by longboat; with time to play in the rapids. Afternoon tea at our Guest-house accommodation.

Take an evening/sunset walk in the cooling air with our guide. Look for birds and other local wildlife as the jungle changes from day to night mode.

Next morning, enjoy a guided rainforest walk along wooden pathways and jungle trails to a spectacular lookout at Bukit Patoi. Return to our Guest-house to clean up before driving to Bangar town for lunch in a local café. Visit the shops if time permits, then return to BSB by water taxi.

0615	Breakfast
0730	Depart in longboat to the National Park and then to Sungai Apan (subject to river level): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Canopy walkway • Waterfall walk and swimming • River skills training (optional)
1130	Depart Sungai Apan to National Park centre: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Longboat and/or paddle <i>Rapid Rider</i> down the river.
1230	Arrive National Park centre: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Lunch, swim, walkways & relax.
1500	Depart downstream in longboat
1615	Arrive at our Guest-house: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Afternoon tea and relax
1745	Depart for evening walk: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Enjoy a pre-dinner walk in the cool of the evening. Look for wildlife.

	Day 3:
0630	Rise and breakfast
0730	Depart in vehicle to Bt Patoi for guided jungle walk on walkways and jungle paths.
1100	Return to Guest-house to clean-up then to Bangar town for lunch, and shops.
1330	Depart Bangar in water taxi for Bandar
1415	Arrive Bandar Seri Begawan.

We will provide:

- All meals, morning and afternoon teas & drinks along the way
- Accommodation on both nights in our Malay style Guest-house, with air-conditioned rooms with bathroom. Beds, bedding and towel supplied.
- An experienced guide to describe the environment, the local lifestyles and the wildlife.
- All transport - land and water
- Lots to see, learn and do
- Raincape - in case of a shower
- Activity equipment - eg, life-jackets (PFD-1) - children sizes available

Please bring:

- Comfortable clothing (eg: lightweight long pants and shirts)
- A change of clothes
- Sun protection - creams, long clothes and hat
- Old shoes (that can get wet and dirty) suitable for walking over slippery ground.
- Swimming costume
- Toiletries
- Towel for swimming
- Camera - plus film
- Small torch & spare batteries
- An effective sun hat (with chin strap)
- Some snacks if you think you'll get hungry on route (please don't drop the wrappers).
- Plastic bags to waterproof your valuable items (eg: camera) on the river trips
- Your favourite insect repellent

Please: Bring your clothes in a soft sports bag or rucksack - no suitcases in the jungle please. (Excess luggage can be left in our BSB office or Temburong Guest-house)

Notes:

1. This programme involves early starts, walks on sometimes slippery pathways, bumpy boat rides, getting wet, and clambering about. However, it is well within the capabilities of healthy people.
2. Life jackets, helmets, other safety equipment, and activity operating practices, are in accord with recognised international standards
3. We will be visiting a longhouse. Please wear conservative clothing - long pants and shirts.
4. Temburong is remarkably free of biting insects, (hills and flowing rivers rather than flat areas with pooled water), but some people are more susceptible than others. Please bring your favourite insect repellent that works for you.

Optional activities at additional cost:

Bicycles - additional Bn\$25 per person

Rafting - additional Bn\$30 each - Min 3 x guests - with helmet and life-jacket. Please book in advance

Rafting Option:

This is a fun experience with grade 1 or 2 rapids to add some thrills while paddling downstream from the National Park in our 6 person inflatable rafts. The Temburong River is especially suited to beginners and families. Drift with the current, listen to the sounds of the jungle and watch for birds and other wildlife. Our staff will brief you on the techniques and safety procedures.

NOTES:

1. We provide PFD-1 life-jackets (children sizes available) and safety helmets.
2. Minimum booking of 3 x paddlers.
3. Including this activity will involve some small changes to the day's timetable.
