



7D6N Beijing/Chengde/Tianjin Muslim Tours

D1 Beijing (B/L/D)

Arrival Beijing. Check-in hotel. Visit **the Summer Palace**. It is the largest imperial garden in China, the Summer Palace was first built in the Qing emperor Qianlong's time in 1751 and burned down in 1860 by the French and British army and restored by the Dowager empress Cixi for her own enjoyment. It became a favorite haunt of Cixi, who preferred it to the Forbidden City., and named it Yihe Yuan meaning the garden of health and harmony. Lunch. Enjoy the tea ceremony at **Chinese Tea House**. Visit to the Ma Dian Mosque which is one of the most famous mosques with hundreds years history. **Pray at MaDian Mosque**. After dinner, enjoy **Acrobatic Show**.



D2 Beijing (B/L/D)

Today is the highlight of our China tour, the climbing of the Great Wall of China, which was first built in the in the Warring States period (475—221BC) as a series of earthworks erected by individual kingdoms as a defense against each other as well as from invasion from the north. The present-day wall was left from the Ming dynasty. Lunch at a local Muslim restaurant near the Great Wall. Shopping at **Jade and Crystal center**. Visit the **Chinese Medical Cream center** with Chinese KongFu Show.



D3 Beijing (B/L/D)



Morning visit to the TianAnMen Square which is the largest city square in the world, bordered by the Great Hall of the People and Chairman Mao's Mausoleum, then tour **the Forbidden City**, the complex of imperial palace, which was home to the Emperors for over 500 years. Grand halls and courts gradually give way to more intimate domestic quarters, giving an insight into the pampered isolation of the emperors. Enjoy traditional **Free Foot Massage** at the Chinese medicine center.

Take a short visit to the new highlight of Beijing, the incredible Olympic Village with its **Bird's Nest Stadium**. After lunch, go to Nantouya Mosque for salat. Shopping at **the Sunny Gold Street**. **Enjoy the fashion show** at local famous **Silk Center**.

D4 Beijing/Tianjin/Beijing (B/L/D)

Transfer to Tianjin. Meaning Port to Heavenly Capital. Tianjin is 130 kilometers southeast of Beijing.,Serving as Beijing's gateway to the Bohai Sea. People started to settle in Tianjin in the Song Dynasty (960—1279A.D). By the 15th century it had become a garrison town enclosed by walls. However, Tianjin suffered a lot during the Boxing Revolution in 1900 when the walls were torn down to make sure that Tianjin could never again be used as a sanctuary. During those chaotic years, Tianjin is now one of China's leading manufacturing and commercial centers. Visit **Food street** and **Culture street**. Visit the **Great Mosque**. Transfer back to Beijing.



D5 Beijing/Chengde (B/L/D)

After breakfast, transfer to Chengde(3.5 hrs). After lunch, **pray at Great Mosque**. Visit **Summer Resort**. It is situated in the north part of the city center of Chengde, Hebei. It is here that the emperor of Qing dynasty to spend summer holidays and handle government affairs. It was originally built in Kangxi 42nd year(1703), and finished in Qianlong 57th year(1792). The total acreage is 5640 thousand m², with a building area of about 100 thousand m², and there are more than 110 construction sites and all together 184 scenic spots (including the 36 sites titled by Kangxi and Qianlong); the winding palace wall is more than 190km long; it is the biggest ancient emperor palace now exist in China. **Check-in hotel.**



D6 Chengde/Beijing (B/L/D)

After breakfast, return back Beijing. Shopping at Yashow market. Pray at Nandouya mosque. Sightseeing & Shopping in Wangfujing Street.

D7 Beijing/Home (B)

Departure Beijing after breakfast.
